- An education/childcare qualification to at least NVQ Level 2 *is desirable but not essential*

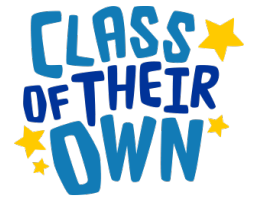
Work experience:
